The next stop will be Gallup which is home to most of the major trading posts in the state. We will then be visiting the Zuni Pueblo for in-home demonstrations by local craftsmen. We will also be visiting Sky City (Acoma Pueblo), one of the oldest continually inhabited cities in North America. Our tour will end with four wonderful days in Albuquerque where we will have front row seats for the Albuquerque Balloon Festival.
